In regular adjourned session, there convened all members of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk.

The County Engineer reported to the Board that the Kaser Construction Co. now located at Lecompton, was desirous of either renting or purchasing one of the county's shovels, which they need badly in their work. Mr. Kaser said that his company would be willing to employ the county operator along with the shovel. Mr. Kaser asked for an answer as quickly as possible as his company is scheduled to start advance production by the 15th of June, and they have to have this equipment to carry on their work. The Board said that it would discuss this matter with the County Engineer further and give Mr. Kaser an answer later on.

The Engineer asked that Fred McFish, employee in his department, be placed on a monthly salary base and asked for \$80.00 per month. This was approved by the Commissioners. In addition thereto, other wage changes were made as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners, with a majority of the members present, namely Ed Johnson and J. M. Sanderson, and County Clerk, T. R. Gerhart also present, met in regular adjourned session.

The morning session was adjourned for the purpose of viewing real estate properties on which the Board of Equalization had received complaints.

In the P. M., all members of the Board and the County Clerk again reconvened in the regular offices of the Commissioners.

C. B. Hosford presented the following petition to the Board from interested parties petitioning the establishing of Sewer District No. 3:

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY:

The undersigned being the owners of one hundred percent of the following described land:

- (1) "Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Sec. 6-13-20, thence East on Section Line 4 99/100 chains, thence North parallel with the West boundary of said Quarter Section 4 865/1000 chains, thence West parallel with the South Boundary of said Quarter Section 4 99/100 chains, thence South 4 865/100 chains to beginning."
- (2) "The South 466 feet of the following described tract. The South 4 1/2 acres of the East 9 acres of the West 19 acres of the South one-half of the Southeast of Section 6-13-20, less the following - (Beginning at a point on the South boundary of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6-13-20, 5 chains East of the Southwest corner of said quarter section, thence East 100 feet, thence North 230 feet, thence West 100 feet, thence South 230 feet to beginning."
- (3) "Beginning at a point on the South boundary of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6-13-20, 5 chains East of the Southwest Corner of said Quarter Section, thence East 100 feet, thence North 230 feet, thence West 100 feet, thence South 230 feet to beginning."

Hereby respectfully request that you create a Sanitary Sewer District embracing the said lands, and that the cost thereof be spread over a ten year period and apportioned to the owners of said land as provided by law.

You are informed that we now have a Right-of-way along the South line of Lot 7, Block 11, Haskell Place, from the sewer across said Lot East to Barker Avenue which adjoins the lands embraced in this petition.

In event this petition is granted, you are authorized to enter into such a contract for maintenance of said sewer, as was entered into by your Board and the City of Lawrence, with respect to Sewer District Number One.
