With a majority of the members present, the County Board of Commissioners met in regular adjourned session, there being present, also, the County Clerk.

The Commissioners of Douglas County met as a Board this 17th day of June in regular adjourned session; there also being present T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk.

The following cancellation order was passed:

No. 258: "CANCEL \$1.00 Dog Tax assessed to H. C. Marshall, 1219 Prospect (Fairfax). Dog is a male and was assessed as a female dog."

The Commissioners approved the request of E. E. Larson, County Engineer to pay extra help 40¢ per hour. At the present time, the Engineer has two extra men working in his department.

A discussion on the county health unit was held with Dr. H. L. Chambers, Howard Weindel and Mr. Walker, Sanitation officers and a representative from the state board.

The Commissioners signed certain papers for Mary White which are necessary for her admittance to the Bickledyke Home.

Don Kaser of the Kaser Construction Company, now operating in Lecompton, and the County Engineer met with the Commissioners for the purpose of discussing the purchase of a power shovel from the county. The Commissioners had reached the decision to sell one of the county's shovels to this company and pursuant thereto, the County Attorney drew up the following agreements:
