Action on the following resolution was taken by motion of J. M. Sanderson who moved that the Board adopt said resolution to transfer money from the County Road and Bridge Fund to the Special Road and Bridge Machinery and Equipment Fund. A second was made by Ed Johnson. On wote, called by Chairman Griffith, all commissioners voted in the affirmative.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, as of December 31, 1942, there is a cash balance in the Road and Bridge Fund in the amount of \$38,237.29 and an unencumbered budget balance of approximately \$20,800.00, and

WHEREAS, it was provided in Chapter 317, Laws of Kansas, 1941 that "the governing body of any municipality by resolution is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer, annually, from the road, bridge or street fund of such municipality not to exceed twenty-five per cent of the amount of money credited to any such fund, and subject to legal expenditure in such year to a special road, bridge or street building machinery and equipment fund", and

WHEREAS, the total budget for 1942 in the amount of \$64,920.00 represents the amount of money that would be subject to expenditure during 1942 and \$16,230.00 would be twenty-five per cent of that amount subject to transfer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that \$16,230.00 be transferred from the County Road and Bridge Fund to the Special Road and Bridge Machinery and Equipment Fund.
