County Commissioners, namely, L. H. Griffith, Chairman, Ed Johnson and M. N. Penny, Commissioners, and the County Clerk T. R. Gerhart, met in the regular meeting rooms of said Board.

Further bills against the county for materials and supplies were presented by the County Clerk, and after close inspection, the Commissioners allowed same by proper motion in amounts as recorded in the Allowance Record.

Commissioners minutes for the meetings held on February 1 and February 3, were read and approved.

For a general discussion on engineering matters appeared C. E. Redmond \mathcal{P} County Engineer, Alva T. Hodges and Roy Hegeman, members of the Road and Bridge Department. Since Hodges is leaving the employ of the county of February 15, the Board took formal action as per the following motion;

Ed Johnson moved that the county advance Roy Hegeman to the position of General Foreman of the Road and Bridge Crews, replacing Alva "Buck" Hodges, who is leaving the employ of the county, and that said Roy Hegeman receive a \$10.00 wage increase (\$140.00 to \$150.00) per month, same effective on Fobruary 15, 1943. N. N. Penny seconded the motion. On vote, called by Chairman Griffith, all commissioners voted "Aye".

The County Clerk discussed the full-time employment of Mrs. Will Johns, Jr., her services being needed because of the approaching assessment period in March. The Commissioners approved said employment at the Clerk's recommendation, Mrs. Johns to receive the salary of \$75.00 per month.
