The Acting County Engineer, C. E. Redmond, and the Road and Bridge Foreman, Roy Hegerman, appeared before the Board to discuss the matter of filling the ditch leading from Baldwin Creek to Lake View Lake.

At this time, the Acting Engineer also made a request for wage adjustments of the Road and Bridge Department. After some discussion, a motion was made by M. N. Penny, seconded by Ed Johnson and unanimously voted, that the employees of the road and bridge crews, the office clerk and the Acting County Engineer receive the increase of \$10.00 per month. Exceptions are Wm. I. Tucker, Blacksmith and Nelson Olmstead, Patrolman, who both are new employees of the county. The 1944 salary schedule is as follows:
