discuss the hook-up for electrical service at the county's rock quarry. They said that it will require about five miles of wiring plus all the other equipment necessary. They thought it would cost approximately \$3600.00 to do this work. Also, application would have to be made to the War Production Board. However, they said they would make further study of this and determine what service charge to the county would be necessary if they make such an investment.

The Board adjourned to meet Wednesday, January 12, 1944.
