Nothing definite on appointing a County Treasurer could be done this day. The Treasurer's office is to be closed during the audit which is to be made by Er.French.

After Mr.French's arrival, he reported to the Board that although his audit was not complete, he had made a complete enough check to know that everything was in order in the Treasurer's office.

Roy Flory, the present deputy County Treasurer, was appointed as Acting County Treasurer, and Mr. Gardner's bond will be cancelled and transferred to Roy Flory.

Thereupon, the following Resolutions, by proper motion, second and wote, were adopted by the Board.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, due to the untimely and sudden death of A. M.Gardner, County Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, there is now a vacancy in that office, and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of said county and state, convened in regular adjourned session this 14th day of June, 1944, that Roy Flory be appointed to serve as Acting County Commissioner until such time as Mr.Gardner's successor can be qualified.
