

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD N

Douglas County Board of Commissioners, Lawrence, Kansas

The Board directed that beginning July 1st, 1944, \$10.00 per month will be charged Dale McMillen for rental of house at Lone Star.

The following resolution authorizing the County Attorney to proceed with the Judicial Tax Sale was adopted. Said sale to include all properties on which taxes are delinquent since the years 1937 and 1938.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Counties are directed by Section 79-2801 to 79-2807 General Statutes, 1935, Supp. of 1943 to file a foreclosure suit and sell lands, which have been carried on the tax rolls for a certain number of years, without having had the taxes paid thereon, and

WHEREAS, there are numerous parcels of land on the tax rolls of Douglas County, which have been carried on the rolls of this County without having said taxes paid thereon, which would be subject to the judicial sale referred to above, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the said Douglas County to proceed to sell the said property and place the land back on the tax rolls on a paying basis.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Attorney of Douglas County be instructed as provided by law to proceed with the judicial sale as directed by the sections above mentioned and to institute and carry out to completion the said proceeding.

The above resolution was presented and discussed by the members of the Douglas County Board. It was moved by Ed Johnson and seconded by M. N. Penny that the resolution be adopted.

The resolution was carried by a unanimous vote.
