

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD N

Douglas County Republicans, Lawrence

July 26, 1944

All members of the Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session.

The matter of appointing a County Treasurer to fill the vacancy left by the death of A. M. Gardner, was again brought up for serious consideration by the board.

The appointment of a County Treasurer had been discussed at various times at former meetings, but no appointment had been made up to present time and Roy Flory, former deputy, has been acting in the capacity as Acting County Treasurer.

It was suggested at this meeting that Fred W. Kahn, present Deputy County Clerk, be offered the position, and after his acceptance the following motion was made: M. N. Penny moved that Fred W. Kahn be appointed as County Treasurer, for the balance of the late A. M. Gardner's term, said Mr. Kahn to take office on August 1, 1944. Ed Johnson seconded the motion. On vote called by Mr. Griffith, the motion carried.

The Commissioners' order cancelling taxes levied against property purchased for the use of the County as County Convalescent Hospital.
