August 1, 1944

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session, all members of the board being present.

Regular claims for salaries and wages were presented to the Board by the County Clerk, and after close scrutiny and by proper motion, second and vote, were allowed as per amounts on Allowance Record.

The Board upon the request of County Engineer, E.E. Larson, increased the salary of Walter Dimery, from \$110.00 to \$120.00 per month, effective the first of August.

County Clerk T.R. Gerhart, announced that Glema D. Davis, Secretary in his office, has been appointed as Deputy County Clerk.

The Board adjourned to meet Friday, August 4th.

August 4, 1944

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session for the specific purpose of canvassing poll books of the Primary Election, as provided by law.

All poll books of the various election precincts in the county, were carefully checked as to tally, and corrections were duly made. All corrections were minor and will result in no change in the election outcome.

The candidates for Precinct Committeeman in the 2nd Precinct of the 2nd Ward, Edward Bumgardner and W. J. Baumgartner, received tie vote, namely, 75; therefore, they were requested by the Board to appear before the Commissioners so that the vote may be decided by lot.

Both parties appeared and approved the method of flipping a coin to decide the vote whereupon the flip of the coin decided the vote in favor of W. J. Baumgartner, who was declared elected to the office.

The Bond of Fred W. Kahn, newly appointed County Treasurer, in the amount of \$50,000.00 was approved by the Board.

The Board adjourned to meet August 7th, 1944.
