The proposal of Allen French for making the annual audit for the consideration of \$1100.00 was formally accepted.

A contract was placed with R. L. Forbes (sublet to D. L. Higgins) for painting in the County Treasurer's office, for the sum of \$260.00.

August 30, 1944

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board and the County Clerk being present.

Room changes in the office of the Budget Director and the Commissioners' room were discussed, and formal action was taken to make the change.

A hot water heating plant for the home at the county farm was discussed. Mr. Larson reported that such a furnace could be purchased of Gene Brune for approximately \$375.00. Mr. Larson was authorized to purchase said furnace from Mr. Brune, provided the County can realize the difference between the sale price of the boilers and the \$375.00 to be expended for the new furnace.

Mr. Larson also reported that the floor is being laid and finished in the new house at the farm, at 10¢ a square foot. He also reported that the bridge over the Little Wakarusa, southwest of Eudora, is being repaired, and that a Mr. E. L. Eberhart is being added to the Road & Bridge crew to replace Porter, who is quitting the first of September.

The Board discussed purchasing certain material for the new bridge over the Wakarusa at the County farm so that half of the money can be obligated by the first of the year, as required by statute.

No further business, the board adjourned.
