Mr. Riling dictated the following letter to be enclosed with each beer license grantod this day, and also to be mailed to the persons who have already received their licenses, by recistered mail.

"The Board of County Commissioners desire to call your attention to Article 27 of the 1943 Supplement, to the General Statutes of Kansas, 1935, which provides in detail the way you should operate a place of business where you are permitted to sell beer under the enclosed license.

You should familiarize yourself, thoroughly, with everyprovision in this law. If this law is violated, in any respect, your beer license will be revoked as provided in this act.

We are not obligated to call your attention to the provisions of this act, but believe it wise to do so.

Mr. Riling also dictated a letter to the Mayor and City Council, calling attention to the six persons who have been convicted for operating and maintaining gambling devices in their places of business, and also notifying the "City Council that if any of these persons apply for a license and the license is granted, the Board of County Commissioners intend to revoke the same by virtue of Article 27 of the 1943 Supplement.

Krs. Hurley, County Superintendent, appeared before the board and asked that the salary of the deputy in her office be increased to \$100.00. After some discussion, the increase was granted, effective with the January salary.
