February 1, 1945

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session, Mr. Penny being unable to attend because of illness.

The regular monthly pay roll claims were approved and allowed as per the Allowance Record.

The Board reappointed Ebon R. Anderson as the County Weed Supervisor for the year 1945, with an increase of 50 cents a day starting February 1st, making a total wage of \$4.50 per day. The increase of salary to be taken from the Transportation budget of the bindweed department in the amount of \$100.00, and the balance necessary to be taken from the Chemical budget.

The Board adjourned until February 5th.

February 5, 1945

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session, Mr. Penny being unable to attend because of illness.

Additional bills were approved and allowed as per the Allowance Record.

M. R. Gill appeared before the board in regard to closing the road to be viewed by the board this day, and also in regard to the land in the bend of the creek by the County Farm. Mr. Gill said the road was bad, and that some one, probably the county's tenant at the county farm, had been cutting a road in his field. Mr. Gill also asked for a drainage ditch along the west line of his 80 acres, and reported that the creek bank has slipped in taking the trees with it, but he had a man who was to dike along the creek bank to keep the creek off his farm.

Mr. Griffith advised Mr. Gill, the county would ascertain whether or not Mr. Stevens, the manager of the county farm, was the person who was making a road in Mr. Gill's field, and that if the County is using Mr. Gill's drive way, the county would help keep it in repair. Mr. Gill said he would be glad to pay for rock to be put in his drive way if the County would have it done. Mr. Johnson said it would take approximately 150 yards of rock to rock the drive which is 1100 feet long.

Mr. Gerhart presented a request for the cancellation of a dog tax which was assessed against Mabel Glass, and also against A. E. Glass. The Board authorized the cancellation as set out below in Order No. 372.

Order No. 372: To cancel the 1944 dog tax assessed against Mrs. Mabel Glass, 905 Tennessee Street, City of Lawrence, as the dog was also assessed against A. E. Glass.

The Board adjourned to meet at 2 o'clock P.M. this day, at the beginning of the road petitioned to be vacated by C. J. Knox and others, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 118 feet east of the intersection of the North line of Section 7, Township 13, Range 20, Douglas County, Kansas, with the east line of the right of way of the A.T. & S.F. railroad; thence South 1007.6 feet, thence East 510 feet, thence South 1303 feet, thence East to the East line of said section, and terminating at North & South highway along the East side of said section.

The Board to meet again on February 6th to take final action on the road.

The Board meeting adjourned until Tuesday February 5th, at 2:30 o'clock P.M.
