Geo. J. Johnson appeared before the board, asking to paint the flag poles, after some discussion, it was agreed to have Mr. Johnson paint the flag pole in the corner of the court house lawn and the flag pole on top of the court house, for the sum of \$35.00 as per the contract on file in the office of the County Clerk.

After viewing the property in Marion Township, belonging to Mrs. E. M. Tenney, 1711 Massachusetts, it was the decision of the board to reduce the total valuation of the real estate, to the sum of \$19,000. as follows:
