The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

The following resolution was approved and signed, cancelling the personal property tax judgment against the Interstate Bakeries according to the action of the board at the meeting on July 11th.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the matter of the personal property tax judgment against Interstate Bakeries Corporation, came on for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, at a regular adjourned meeting this 25th day of July, 1945, said lien appearing in Judgment Docket 8, page 325, in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Douglas County, Kansas, and being more particularly described as follows:

Warrant No. 307, for the year 1944, in the sum of \$2.54 plus fees and interest, filed March 10, 1945.

Thereupon, after full consideration of the matter, and after hearing evidence presented in behalf of Interstate Bakeries Corporation, the Board finds that said assessment was an erroneous assessment and should be cancelled.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the Clerk of the District Court be ordered to cancel said judgment, together with all interest and penalties thereon, on the judgment docket.
