August 6, 1945

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session, all members of the board being present.

Additional claims for supplies and services were approved and allowed, as per the Allowance Record.

The boards of Wakarusa and Eudora Townships met with the board in response to the request of the board of County Commissioners, in regard to the old Eudora Road. After discussion, the boards of the two townships agreed to repair the road immediately.

The following resolution was adopted, closing all places selling cereal malt beverages on VJ Day.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Paragraph 21-2704, General Statutes of Kansas, 1939 Supplement, authorizes and empowers the Boards of County Commissioners of the several Counties to prescribe hours of closing, standards of conduct, make and adopt rules and regulations concerning the moral, sanitary and health conditions of places of business licensed to sell cereal malt beverages outside the limits of any incorporated city in the County;

AND WHEREAS, after investigation, the said County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, believe that it would be to the best interests of the community that all places of business licensed to sell cereal malt beverages outside the limits of any incorporated city in the County, should be closed on VJ-Day.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that any place of business licensed to sell cereal malt beverages outside the limits of any incorporated city in Douglas County, Kansas, shall be required to close such places of business on VJ-Day.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, met in special session, all members of the board being present.

The commissioners, being dissatisfied with the services rendered by Mr. and Mrs. Clyde Conner, the caretakers of Long Star Lake and Park, such services were terminated this day, effective Monday August 13th, with payment in full for the month of August. E. H. Sanders was asked to handle the sale of the licenses at the lake and to police the lake, which he agreed to do for the fee of 10¢ a license sold. Mr. and Mrs. D. H. Heckman were hired to be in charge of the cabins, to recondition and maintain the same, at the wage of \$125.00 a month, starting August 13th.
