Warrant No. 8457, for the year 1938, in the sum of \$120.17, plus fees and interest, filed October 22, 1940.

Warrant No. 9298, for the year 1939, in the sum of \$46.83, plus fees and interest, filed February 20, 1941.

Warrant No. 8456, for the year 1938, in the sum of \$2.04, plus fees and interest, filed April 24, 1944.

Warrant No. 7213 for the year 1937, in the sum of \$2.61, plus fees and interest, filed April 24, 1944.

Said Board after full consideration of the matter, finds that it would be to the best interest of Douglas County to compromise said tax for the sum of \$290.88, which represents the payment of one-half of the net tax, exclusive of penalties and interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the Clerk of the District Court, be ordered to cancel all interest and penalties on the tax judgments, listed above, and to accept the sum of \$290.88, for full settlement of same, the remaining one-half of tax and interest and penalties being hereby waived.

J. J. Eddy, appeared before the board, asking for the cancellation of a personal property tax judgment against him as Agent for the owner at 1016 Alabama, on the 1938 taxes. After Mr. Eddy presented an affidavit stating he was not and has never been agent for anyone at that address, the following resolution was adopted:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the matter of an offer to compromise personal property tax judgment against J. J. Eddy, as agent, came on for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, at a regular adjourned meeting this 17th day of October, 1945, said lien appearing in Judgment Docket 8, page 11 in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Douglas County, Kansas, and being more particularly described as follows:

Warrant No. 8367, for the year 1938, in the sum of \$3.53, plus fees and interest, filed September 20, 1941.

THEREUPON, after hearing evidence presented by the said J. J. Eddy, and being fully convinced that these delinquent taxes were assessed against Mr. Eddy in error, the Board finds it only fair and just to cancel the tax lien judgment including all penalties and interest.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, at the Clerk of the District Court be ordered to cancel the tax judgment described above, in the total amount of \$3.53, plus all interest and penalties now on his docket against J. J. Eddy, sworn affidavit of Mr. Eddy being attached hereto.
