December 6, 1945

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session, all members of the Board being present.

The meeting was called at the request of T.F. Yost, State Bindweed Supervisor, to discuss and outline the 1946 bindweed eradication program.

It was moved by Mr. Penny that Lawrence Rice be placed on the payroll in the County Engineers office at \$150.00 a month and Bill Henderson at \$175.00 a month, beginning December 1st, 1945.

Commissioners' Orders No. 393, 394 and 395 were approved and issued as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, met in regular adjourned session, all members of the board being present.

Additional bills for services and supplies were approved and allowed as per the Allowance Record.

Robert B. Cyler, County Attorney presented a letter from the Attorney General's office at Topeka which stated a state permit for selling beer could not be issued to Carol Miller of Douglas County, as the records in Wichita show he has a federal retail dealers license for wines and hard liquors, and under the Kansas Statutes the Board of County Commissioners cannot issue the beer license. A letter was written Mr. Miller notifying him of the conditions and that the Board could not issue his license.

County Commissioners Orders No. 396, 397 and 398 were issued as follows:
