# COMMISSIONER'S RECORD N

Douglas County Republican, Lawre

Sheriff Skinner, Deputy Sheriff Archie Dumas and Lawrence Chief of Folice Bliesner, and members of the Lawrence City Council appeared before the board to discuss the enforcement of the rabies quarantime. In a joint meeting of the '-- Board of County Commissioners and a Committee from the City Council with the authorization to act, the motion was made, seconded and carried, that the City and County cooperate together in the enforcement of the quarantime, each furnishing one man and one half of the operating expense of the truck at the rate of \$90. a month, or \$45. each. Sheriff Skinner was directed to work with the City to see about establishing a regular dog pound.

The following resolution regulating the sanitation and operation of beer joints in the County was adopted:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, deem it expedient, practicable and adviseable, to make certain regulations to be followed in regard to the selling of CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES in Douglas County, Kansas.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas;

"SECTION I"

### LICENSE: APPLICATION: FEE

No person shall sell any Cereal Malt Beverage at retail within the County of Douglas, the City of Lawrence excepted, without having first procured a license therefor from the County Commissioners of said county. A separate license shall be required for each place of business retailing Cereal Malt Beverages. The application for said license shall be made upon a form prescribed by the Attorney General. Said form can be obtained from the Douglas County Clerk in the Court House at Lawrence, Kansas.

Such application shall be verified and shall be accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00). Said license shall be issued for calendar year. The full amount of the license fee shall be required regardless of the time of the year in which the application is made, and the licensee shall only be authorized to operate under the license for the remainder of the calendar year in which the license was issued. No license shall be transferable. The license shall be kept posted in a conspicuous place in his place of business.

#### "SECTION II"

## CONDUCT: REGULATIONS: SANITATION

The place of business licensed and operating under said Board of County Commissioners shall abide by the following health regulations:

A. Licenseq, shall have in his place of business, a sanitary sewerage disposal with a minimum of one WPA type toilet.

B. Glasses and eating utensils of the licensee shall be washed in hot scapy water and rinsed in an approved chlorine solution for a minimum of two minimum of two minutes before being reused.

C. The premises must be kept in a sanitary condition at all times.

D. The premises and all equipment used in connection with said business, shall be kept clean and in a sanitary condition and stall times be open to the inspection of the Sheriff's office and health office of said county.

#### "REGULATIONS"

A. No Cereal Malt Beverages will be sold in said county between the hours of 12:00 o'clock midnight and 6:00 o'clock a.m. or on Sunday or on any election day.

B. No person under the age of eighteen years shall be permitted to buy or drink any such bewerage in or about said place of business nor shall any person under eighteen years of age be employed by a licensee operating under these regulations.

C. The licenses shall allow no one to bring any whiskey, gin or any liquor whatsoever into or upon the premises used by the licensee under these regulations.

D. The licensee shall permit no gambling or any gambling devices such as slot machines, in his place of business when he has a license to operate under these regulations.

E. The licensee shall permit no excessive noise or allow vulgar language to be used in or about his place of business that would disturb others or become a nuisance.

F. No licensee operating under these regulations shall furnish facilities for or permit any dancing in or about the premises of his place of business.

These regulations are made by the Board of County Commissioners in addition to all laws and regulations made and provided by the State of Kansas. The Board of County Commissioners shall revoke any license when there is any violations of the State Law pertaining to the operation of a licensee to sell Cereal Mait Beverages or for any of the above regulations as heretofore set out."

## "SECTION III"

#### SAVING CLAUSE:

Should any Court declare any section, clause or provision of this Resolution to be unconstitutional, such shall affect only such section, clause or provision so declared unconstitutional and shall not affect any other section, clause or provision of these regulations.
