present drainage ditch and Baldwin's Branch and running thence in or down said drainage ditch in a Northwesterly direction toward Lake View, equipped with a knife flood gate at the junction of said pipeline with said Baldwin's Branch for the purpose of regulating the flow of water in and out of said Baldwin's Branch and along said drainage ditch.

(b) The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, agrees to furnish at proper and reasonable times when such work is to be accomplished the services of not less than four and not more than six dump trucks for the purpose of erecting said levee and raising said roads, together with men to operate the same, until said project is completed.

(c) The Board of Trustees of Wakarusa Township agrees to furnish one dump truck at such reasonable and proper times as said work is in progress, together with sufficient men to operate the same, until said entire project is completed.

(d) The said Owen Mitchell agrees to furnish a bulldozer and tractor to operate the same at reasonable and proper times, together with sufficient men to operate the same, until the completion of the entire project.

(e) The said David McCreath agrees to permit the excavation and removal of sufficient earth off of his land at and from a place or places to be designated by him for the completion of the entire project, and to contribute the sum of \$500.00 in cash.

(f) The said The Lake View Fishing and Shooting Association agrees to contribute the sum of \$500.00 in cash.

SUPERVISION:

The entire project is to be done under the supervision and control of E.E. Larson, County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, without remuneration other than as may be paid to him by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.

TIME OF PERFORMANCE:

Said work and project shall be begun as soon as this contract is signed and executed by all the parties hereto and shall be completely performed as soon thereafter as weather conditions shall permit.
