IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS: 1. In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to be paid by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and further covenants and promises herein contained, the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, does hereby grant to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, the right to connect the sewer system of said Douglas County Sewer District No. 5, to the sewer system of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, at a point with Sewer manhole A-25 located as described above.

2. As a part of the consideration of the above, the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, do agree that at such time as, in the opinion of the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, it will be necessary to build or rebuild main sewers in said City, which main sewers under the present law, are paid for by the City at large, that at such time the Board of County Commissioners, on behalf of said Douglas County Sewer District No. 5, will pay to the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, such part of the costs of such new sewers as the value of the real estate in Douglas County Sewer District No. 5, shall bear to the value of the real estate in Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, subject to tax for the construction of such sewer, plus the value of real estate in Douglas County Sewer District No. 5.

3. As one of the conditions to the above right, the said Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, does hereby agree that nothing shall be permitted to enter the sewer system of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, from said Douglas County Sewer District No. 5, except such matters as are proper under the present ordinances of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and any amendments which may be

The said noard of commissioners of boughes county, which, do it which ages that is residence shall be connected with the sever system in the said Dourlas County Sever District No. 5, until the plumbing thereof shall have been inspected by the authorities, and no house hereafter built shall be allowed to connect with said sever system unless the plumbing thereof shall have been shall be allowed to connect with said sever system unless the plumbing thereof shall have been installed in all respects in conformity with the ordinance of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, relating to plumbing, and until the owner of such residence shall have paid to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, the sum of \$50.00 and shall have agreed to all the conditions of this contract including the granting of the right to the officials of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, to go upon his property at any time, inspect the sever system thereof, disconnect said system if the occupant of such property is not complying with this contract and the ordinances of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, relating to the sewers and sewerage.

5. The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County further agrees to pay to the City of Lawrence, annually a sum of money equal to the amount which would be raised on all real estate in Douglas County Sewer District No. 5, by a tax on all said real estate equal to the levy made in such year by the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, on the real estate within said City of Lawrence, Kansas, for the maintenance, upkeep and repair of the sewers of said City. The amount so raised shall apply on the cost of upkeep of the city sewer main with which District No. 5 connects.

6. IT IS FURTHER AGREED, that should any house be connected with said sewer system of the 6. IT IS FURTHER AGREED, that should any house be connected with said sewer system of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, prior to the payment of said sum of \$50.00 or should any improper matter be permitted to enter the sewer system of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, from said Douglas County Sewer District No. 5, or should a house be permitted to connect with such sewer system where the plumbing thereof has not been inspected and passed by the City of Lawrence, Kansas, or should a new house be connected with said sewer system, the plumbing thereof not being installed in strict conformity with the ordinances of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, then such city may, without notice, disconnect the house from which such improper substance may enter, or which has been connected in violation of this agreement.
