WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in accordance with Section 19-2704 to 19-2709, inclusive, General Statutes of Kansas, 1935, and amendments thereto, 1945 Supplement, signed by C. R. Guffin, Mrs. C. R. Guffin, Roy W. Rogers, Mrs. Roy Rogers, Kenneth W. Franks, Mrs. Kenneth W. Franks, L. A. Guffin, Mrs. L. A. Guffin, W. M. Leonhart, Mrs. Doris Leonhart, Gerald I. Hoover, Mrs. Wilda Hoover, Miss Nettie M. Wismer, Garland D. Anderson, Louis K. Zimmer, Stella A. Zimmer, Juliz M. Springer, Forrest J. Springer, Earl E. Hope, Mildred B. Hope, W. A. Eudaly, Minnie E. Eudaly, Orville Flory, Leona Flory, H. W. Miskimen, Ella Miskimen, being the owners of more than 51% of the acreage of the land within the following described benefit district;

"Beginning at a point in the center of Learnard Avenue 627 feet East and 875.5 feet South of the northwest corner of the Southeast 1/4, Section 6, Township 13, Range 20; thence West 230 feet; thence South parallel to the center line of Learnard Avenue 1106.87 feet; thence East 460 feet; thence North parallel with the center line of Learnard Avenue 1167.60 feet to the South line of Lot No. 2 Evergreen Addition; thence West 230 feet to the center line of Learnard Avenue; thence South 60.73 feet to beginning,"

requesting that a sewer district be formed within the boundaries of the above described real estate, and that a sewer system be constructed therein;

WHEREAS, the owners of the land in the proposed district have agreed to pay all the cost incident to establishment and construction of said sewer system; and

WHEREAS, a preliminary engineering survey has been made, and a finding has been made that said sewer district would be practical and beneficial; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have entered into a contract with the City of Lawrence said contract being dated the Second day of May, 1946, in duplicate, and delivered on said date, and said contract being signed by the Mayor of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, C. B. Russell, and by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, L. H. Griffith, and that said contract granted permission to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to connect a sewer system of said Douglas County, the same being Douglas County Sewer District No. 4, to the sewer system of the City of Lawrence at the point of Sewer Man-hole A-29, located in the 2000 block on Learnard Avenue, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, hereby further affirms all the conditions, stipulations, and agreements in said contract as though fully set out herein, and further agrees to perform and carry out all the stipulations and agreements in said contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this First day of August, 1946, that said proposed sewer district should be, and is hereby, created within the boundaries of the above described real estate, said district to be designated as Sewer District No. 4.
