WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have entered into a contract with the City of Lawrence said contract being dated the twelfth day of June, 1946, in duplicate, and delivered on said date, and said contract being signed by the Mayor of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, C. B. Russell, and by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, L. H. Griffith, and that said contract granted permission to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to connect a sewer system of said Douglas County, the same being Douglas County Sewer District No. 5, to the sewer system of the City of Lawrence at the point of Sewer Man-hole A-25, located approximately 500 feet East of intersection of 19th Street and Learned Avenue, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, hereby further affirms all the conditions, stipulations, and agreements in said contract as though fully set out herein, and further agrees to perform and carry out all the stipulations and agreements in said contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this First day of August, 1946, that said proposed sewer district should be, and is hereby, created within the boundaries of the above described real estate, said district to be designated as Sewer District No. 5.
