The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session as required by law to canvass the poll books of the Primary Election which was held on Tuesday, August 6, 1946, County Commissioner M. N. Penny not being present.

The Payroll for the Primary Election was approved and allowed.

The resignation of M. N. Penny was presented to the board in which he requested that he be relieved of the duties of County Commissioner from the First District for the remainder of his term which will expire at the beginning of 1947. Mr. Penny's resignation was placed on file for future consideration.

The canvassing of the poll books of the Primary proceeded. It was the decision of the County Attorney the remaining two County Commissioners could proceed with the assistance of either the County Clerk or the Deputy County Clerks. Mrs. Mildred LeSuer, and Mrs. Evalyn Beery, who are authorized deputies in the County Clerks office assisted with the canvassing. Only minor changes were made in the final tally which did not affect the election to any office.

No further business, the board adjourned to meet Tuesday, August 13, as required by law, to canvass the In-State Absentee Ballots.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session as required by law to canvass the In-State Absentee Ballots, Commissioners Griffith & Johnson being present. No change was made in the final election returns.

Additional bills for supplies and services were approved and allowed as per the allowance Record.

The Board of County Commissioners received a letter from the president of the Lawrence League of Women Voters, Mrs. Karl Kreider, commending them for their action in regard to their passing a half-mill tax levy in the budget for 1947, to be used for health services.

The Sheriff, R. Skinner, was authorized to purchase a 1946 Super Deluxe Ford, Tudor, trading in the 1942 Super Deluxe Ford Tudor which the Sheriff's force is now using, purchase to be made from the Morgan & Mack Motor Company.

On the recommendation of County Engineer E. E. Larson, the salary of W. N. Stevens was raised five (5) dollars per month, beginning with the August payroll, making his salary now \$130.00 a month. Since Albert Wacker now has complete charge of the rock crusher his pay is increased
