Olmsted and Faye J. Olmsted, being the owners of more than 51% of the acreage of the land within the following described benefit district: "The Southeast Guarter (SE_{1}^{1}), of the Northeast Guarter (NE_{1}^{1}), of the South-east Guarter (SE_{1}^{1}), of Section One (1), Township Thirteen South (13S), Range Nineteen East (19E), in Douglas County, Kansas. requesting that a sewer district be formed leading to and serving the above-described real estate, and that such a sewer system be constructed to serve the said real property as a benefit district. WHEREAS, the owners of the land in the proposed district have agreed to pay all the costs incident to establishment of said sever system; and WHEREAS, a preliminary engineering survey has been made, and a finding has been made of record that said sever district would be practical and beneficial; and WHEREAS, the said preliminary engineering survey shows that said sewer construction should be as follows; to-wit: "Beginning at a menhole to be built in the sewer located at the North-east (NE) corner of Lot 27, Learnard's Subdivision, formerly the center of the street known as vacated Fark Flace, thence, West (W) 342 feet, to a manhole." Resolution BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, that twenty (20) temporary notes, each in the amount of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and one temporary note in the amount of Seventy-four Dollars and sixty cents (\$74.60) issued for the purpose of paying the cost of improving Louisiana Street from Nineteenth (19th) Street to Twenty-third (23rd) Street in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and the highway adjoining, be sold to The Lawrence National Bank, Lawrence, Kansas, at par, said notes to bear interest at the rate of two per cent.
