## December 14, 1946.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members being present.

Archie Welch, 546 Maine Street, Lawr'ence, Kansas, appeared before the Board asking for a reduction on stock and store equipment in his store, Welch's Grocery. A reduction of \$400.00 on stock on hand, and \$200.00 on store equipment was granted by the Board.

The motion was made, seconded, and carried that John Emick, Ed Arnold, and Art Peck be appointed as a Board of Appraisers for the Louisiana Street paving job.

As a result of the break-down of Sewer District 4 and 5 into two separate units, the . following resolutions were passed authorizing the issuance of Temporary Sewer Notes:

## RESOLUTION

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COUNTSSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, at Regular Adjourned meeting, December 14th, 1946.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$3158.00, TEMPORARY SEWER NOTES, DCUCLAS COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 4, DCUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in regular adjourned session at 9:00 o'clock a.m. 14th day of December, 1946, L. H. Griffith, Ed Johnson and Emil Heck being present, Chairman L. H. Griffith, presiding.

The following resolution was offered, and after being duly seconded was adopted:

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, requesting creation of a Sanitary Sewer District, to be known as Douglas County Sewer District No. 4; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners did, at a regularly constituted meeting of said Board, find the improvement as prayed for in said petition to be of public utility and necessary; that the petition was signed by more than 51% of the land owners in the benefit district; and that said petition was in all respects in compliance with all provisions of Sections 19-2704 to 19-2714, both, inclusive, of the Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1945; and,

WHEREAS, The Ecard of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has caused an estimate of the costs of said improvement to be made by the City Engineer of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, which said estimate shows that the cost of said improvement is \$3156.00; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did on the 22nd day of May, 1946, enter into a contract with the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, to connect the sewer of said Sewer District No. 4 with the sewer system of the City of Lawrence, Douglas, Kansas, and that the sewage from said District may flow through the main of the sewer system of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas; and,

WHEREAS; The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, does hereby find and determine that The Board of County Commissioners of said County issue and sell temporary notes under the authorization of Section 10-123 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1935, in the aggregate sum of \$3158.00 for the purpose of obtaining money to pay for the aforesaid improvement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS

That said County issue and sell temporary notes in the aggregate sum of \$3158.00 for the purpose of obtaining money to pay for the improvements, known as Sewer District No. 4, located in Douglas County, Kansas.

That said temporary notes be numbered one to four consecutively, three of said notes to be in the Denomination of One Thousand Dollars each and one note to be in the amount of \$158.00, that said notes to be payable to bearer; that said notes be dated the 14th day of December, 1946; that said notes be due two years after date thereof but that said notes be payable sconer at the option of the Ecard of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, when funds from the sale of bonds to be issued to pay the costs of such improvements are available therefor; that said notes bear interest at the rate of two percent (2%) per annum payable semiannually on the 1st day of July and of January, of each year after the date thereof, and that said notes shall be substantially as follows:
