KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, a municipal corporation, for value received, does hereby acknowledge itself to be indebted to, and promises to pay to the bearer hereof, the sum of \$1000.00 in lawful money of the United States of America, on the 1st day of January, 1947, or the due date of the date of the first installment of bonds to be issued for the payment of the improvements hereinafter mentioned, as may be sooner in point of time, together with interest thereon at the rate of two percent per annum, payable semiannually on the 1st day of July, 1947, and the 1st day of January of each year after the date hereof, until the principal sum hereof shall be fully paid, both principal and interest of this note being payable at the office of the Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents, and the full faith, credit and resources of said Board of County Commissioners are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity.

This note is one of a series of notes in the total amount of \$6158.75 issued for the purpose of evidencing the indebtedness heretofore duly authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, for the making of said improvement, to-wit:

For all labor and materials necessary to construct an eight inch (8") lateral sanitary sewer in Sewer District No. 5, in Douglas County, Kansas;

said Sewer District No. 5 to be constructed in full compliance with the provisions, restrictions and limitations of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Kansas, and particularly of Sections 19-2704 and 19-2714, both inclusive, of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1945, and all other laws of the State of Kansas applicable to said issue and this note together with interest to become due thereon, to be paid by said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, reserves the right to pay this note at any time prior to the maturity date thereof.
