The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members being present.

Additional bills for supplies and services were approved and allowed as per the Allowance Record.

The following Resolution was adopted by the Board to include additional roads in the Federal Secondary Road System:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, all members present, have requested that all County Roads be designated on the Federal Secondary system; and  
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wish to extend the system to take in designated township roads, as follows:

"Beginning 2 3/4 miles East of Sibleyville, or the N.E. corner of Section 35, Township 13, Range 20 East, on F.A.S. No. 206, thence south three (3) miles to join our Vinland Clearfield Road."

"Beginning three (3) miles west of Lone Star Lake, or N.W. corner of Section 20, Township 14S, Range 18E, thence West one and one half (1 1/2) miles to intersect with F.A.S. 1273."

"Beginning at a point, two (2) miles N. of Lawrence on Highway #24, North middle of Section 18, Township 12S Range 20E, thence East two and one-half (2 1/2) miles in Douglas County, and one (1) mile in Leavenworth County to intersect with Highway #24."

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County request the State Highway Commission to designate the above described roads be included in the Federal Secondary System, at Lawrence, Kansas, this 11th day of January, 1947.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, legal processes now are being carried out which will result in the sale of the county farm land, the improvements and the personal property located at the county farm;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proceeds of such sales shall be set aside in a special fund, to be called the County Home Improvement fund, which shall be used at such time as the Board of County Commissioners may deem expedient and for the best interest of the county, for the purpose of making necessary improvements and providing necessary equipment in the enlargement of the county home facilities as provided by Section 39-349, of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1935.
