February 1, 1947

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members being present, for the purpose of allowing the payroll and other bills as registored on the county warrant register.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet February 3, the first regular meeting date in the month.

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February 3, 1947

The Board of County Commissioners met in the first regular session of the month, all members being present.

Mrs. Mary Ellen Simmons, Clerk of the Court, appeared before the Commissioners and presented a list of the unclaimed moneys on hand in the office of the Clerk of the Court. The Commissioners ordered such list to be published according to law.

Mildred LeSuer presented the final 1946 Cash and Budget Reports.

The Board approved notices of special assessments on the Louisiana Street paving project and set February 24, 1947, at 7:30 P.E., as the date for hearing of protests in a joint session with the city council.

A delegation headed by Ralph Standing appeared before the Board, complaining of the system of sewage from the Skyline Club, 633 E. 23rd Street. Dr. Mott, County Health Officer, and R. H. Oyler, County Attorney, were also present at this discussion. No action was taken at this time.

The following resolution was passed, vacating certain streets, roads and alley in Vinland, Kansas:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously finds that it is to the best interest of Douglas County, Kansas to vacate the following roads, strepts and alley which are as follows:

> Oak Street, Pleasant Street, Vine Street and the alley between Pleasant Street and Vine Street;

said roads, streets and alley having been a part of the City of Vinland located on the west side of the Atchiason, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad. Said roads, streets and alley being located in

The West Half (W_{Ξ}^1) of the Northwest Quartor (NW_{4}^1) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Fourteen (14), Range Twenty (20), in Douglas County, Kansas;

a plat of said roads, streets and alley being recorded in Plat Book 2 at page 15 in the Register of Deeds Office of Douglas County, Kansas, in Lawrence, Kansas.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Mansas further finds that Douglas County has more than 1200 inhabitants and less than 35,000 inhabitants and said roads, streets, and alley are not a public utility by the reason of nonuse, and said reads, streets and alley have become practically impassable, and the necessity for said reads, streets and alley as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to lay out and repair said roads, streets and alley and to put the same in condition for public travel.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, further finds that the said roads, streets and alley as mentioned above are less than two (2) miles of consecutive roads, streets and alley, and that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County. Kansas vacate said roads, streets and alley in compliance with Section 68-102 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1945.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, in regular session assembled this 3rd day of February, 1947, that the roads, streets and alley, described as follows:

Oak Street, Pleasant Street, Vine Street and the alley between Pleasant Street and Vine Street in that part of Vinland lying West of the Atchieson, Topoka and Santa Fe Railway;

said roads, streets and alloy being shown by plat and recorded in Plat Book 2 at page 15 in the Register of Deods Office be vacated and excluded from the reads, streets and alleys of Douglas County, Kansus; and that this resolution and order shall be entored at length upon the records of County, Kansus; and that this resolution and order shall be entored at length upon the records of the proceedings of this Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansus; and that the County Clerke of Douglas County, Kansus shall certify a copy of this resolution and order to the Register of Doeds of Douglas County, Kansus, which order the Register of Doeds shall record in the deed records of said County and shall write on the margin of the recorded plat of the City of Vinland, the same being recorded in Plat Book 2 at page 15, the following notation:
