"Beginning at a point  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile S of the NW corner of Sec #1, Twp 13 S, R 17 E, thence east  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles to intersect with the present county road,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles S of Stull, all in Kanwaka Township.
