PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, AT REGULAR MEETING, APRIL 2, 1947.

RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,385.67 TEMPORARY NOTES OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, FOR GRADING, CURBING, PAVING AND OTHERWISE IMPROVE MASKELL AVENUE FROM 13th STREET TO THE SOUTH SIDE OF 14th STREET, SAID AVENUE BEING A BOUNDARY LINE STREET TO THE CITY OF LAWRENCE.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, passed a resolution whereby said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, issued four temporary notes, dated July 10, 1946, the first three notes of which were in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and the fourth note being in the amount of three hundred eighty-five dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$385.67), said notes being issued for the purpose of making said improvements, to-wit:

Grading, curbing, paving and otherwise improving Haskell Avenue irom 13th Street to the South side of 14th Street, said Avenue being a boundary line street to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas;

said improvements to be paid for by the issuance of temporary notes and issuance of bonds under the authority of Section 14-451 and 14-452 and Section 10-123 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1935. And said temporary notes were duly repistered by the Auditor of the State of Kansas on September 12, 1946, in Topeka, Kansas.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Dourlas County, Kansas finds that said notes are invalid for the reason that part of the road described above is completely within the City limits of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas that the four temporary notes is used by said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on July 10, 1946, for the purpose of making said improvements, to-wit:

Grading, curbing, paving and otherwise improving Haskell Avenue from 13th Street to the South side of 14th Street, said Avenue being a boundary line street to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas;

are hereby cancelled and the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas is hereby ordered to cancell said temporary notes of record and to cancell said temporary notes.
