A Committee composed of members of the City Council, along with City Engineer J. C. Harper, City Attorney Charles Stough, Mayor James H. Parsons, and County Attorney Bob Oyler, met with the Board by appointment at 10 o'clock A. M. to consider the extending the City limits. The City outlined the legal proceedings. It was decided by the Committee to take in such portions of outlying terri-tory as they are empowered to do by law to take in by ordnance, and then present to the Board a peti-tion, showing by metes and bounds, the description of such property as the City may desire to include within the city limits. within the city limits.

The resignation of H. H. Hobson, Clerk of Willow Springs Township, was received and accepted The Township Trustee of Willow Springs, Carl Schwarz, recommended that Dana E. Hobson be appointed Clerk of Willow Springs Township. The recommendation was adopted by the Board.

The following resolution was rassed by the Board ordering County Attorney Robert B. Oyler to proceed at once with the tax sale of property now delinquent on its taxes:

WHEREAS, Counties are directed by Section 79-2101 to 79-2809 of the 1945 Supplement to the General Statutes of the State of Kansas for 1935, to file foreclosure suit and sell all lots, tracts and pieces of land which have been carried on the tax rolls for a certain number of years and without having had the taxes paid thereon, and

WHEREAS, there are numerous lots, tracts, and pieces of land on the tax rolls of Douglas County which have been carried on the tax rolls of said County without laving said taxes paid thereon, and the said lots, tracts, and pieces of land would be subject to the judicial sale referred to above,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the said Douglas County to proceed to sell the lots, tracts, and pieces of land and place same back on the tax rolls on a paying basis.

The County Commissioners ordered the distribution of the publications (to which the County is entitled) of the League of Kansas Municipalities as per agreement with . John G. Stutz on June 11, 1947, among Douglas County Officials as follows:

The beer application of J. C. Poindexter, Route 1, Baldwin, Kansas, for a license to sell beer at Oak Lodge, 15 miles South of Lawrence, on Highway No. 59, was approved by the Board and the following resolution passed:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of August, 1947, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, the application of J. C. Poindexter for a beer license came on for consideration of said Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said J. C. Poindexter is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Willow Springs Township Board and that no written objection has been filed by the Willow Springs Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant, J. C. Poindexter, be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County, be and he is hereby directed to issue said license.
