Allen French, who is auditing the county books for 1946, appeared before the Board reques-ting a fifty dollar (\$50.00) raise from the Board to audit the books for Douglas County for 1947, or for the amount of one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,250.00), said request being approved by the Board. Mr. French is to submit his contract at the next meeting of the Board.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet Monday, September 29, 1947.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

The Board met as a Board of Road Viewers at 2 o'clock P.M. at the half mile point, on the west line of Section 18, T15S, R21E, in Palmyra Township, to discuss the advisability of changing a private road into a public road, and also widening said road.

The Board acted favorably on the petition, and decided to change the road to Fublic Road #317, and to widen said road to sixty (60) feet, and to come under the jurisdiction of Palmyra Township as a township road. The description of said road is as follows:

"Eeginning at the half mile point, west line of Section 18, Township 15 South, Range 21 East; thence East one mile to the East section line of said Section 18, and recorded as Public Road #317, and being sixty (60) feet wide."

Allen French, who is auditing the books of the County for 1946, appeared before the Board with the Agreement to audit the books of the County for 1947, said agreement as follows:

## AUDIT AGREENENT

THIS ACREELENT: Made and entered into this 29th day of September, 1947, between Allen French (1) Licensed Municipal Public Accountant of Topeka, Kansas, party of the first part, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, party of the second part.

(2) WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of money hereinafter stated, agrees to examine by and through his examiners, the official financial records and accounts of the County Commissioners, County Treasurer, County Clerk, Register of Deeds, Clerk of District Court, Probate Judge, Judge of the County Court, Justices of the Peace, Sheriff, County Attorney, County Superintendent, County Engineer, Bindweed Supervisor and Welfare Director, for the period, January 1, 1947 to December 31, 1947.

(3) Said first party further agrees that, the audit shall be performed in accordance with the general and specific provisions of the Minimum Standard Audit Program approved by the State Municipal Accounting Board, as of October 25, 1940, and subsequent amendments and supplements.

Said first party also agrees to begin the audit on or about August 1, 1948, and to complete (4)the audit by September 30, 1948.

(5) The name and qualifications of the supervisor and senior accountant who may be employed on this contract is; Allen French, Licensed Municipal Public Accountant.

(6) The party of the second part hereby agrees to pay the party of the first part for his services Twelve hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,250.00), payable monthly as the work progresses on services twelve numbered and fifty dollars (01,200.00), payable monully as the work progresses on estimates approved by the County Commissioners, final payment, not less than 33 1/3 % of fee, exclusive of travel and subsistence expenses, to be made when the report is accepted by them, and a notice has been received that a copy thereof has been filed with the State Accountant. The County to receive two complete copies of the auidit report and each official a copy covering his office.

(7) Since this contract covers work to be done in the 1948 budget year the following paragraphs No. 8 and 9 and included, to set up the County's liability as limited by the cash basis and budget laws

(8) On January 2, 1948, the party of the second part agrees to issue a purchase order in favor of the party of the first part in the amount of \$1,250.00 which will be charged to the 1948 budget and cash balances of the County General Fund, and which will be payable according to and within the limitations of the sixth maragraph of this agreement.

(9)Provided however, that where this agreement refers to work to be done during the period January 2, 1948, to September 30, 1948, the agreement shall not be in full force or effect until
