The following resolutions were approved and allowed by the Board for the widening and improving of the designated roads:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the landowners along road Number 471, 22, 246, will donate right of way for the widening and improving of the three and one half ($3\frac{1}{2}$) miles of road between the Lone Star and Globe Roads which are now in the County System.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, State of Kansas, in regular session assembled this 29th day of December, 1947, do grant the addition of the following described county roads to the County System of Highways, and same to be removed from Township system of designated townships.

Beginning at the middle of Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 19 East, thence extending West through the middle of Section 36 and continuing on to the middle of Section 35, thence South one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mile to the South line of Section 35, thence West along South line of Section 35 and to the quarter point on the South line of Section 34, Township 13 South, Range 18 East, or the intersection of the Globe Road; being three and one half ($3\frac{1}{2}$) miles in length and all in Clinton Township with the exception of the West one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mile on the South line of Section 35 and the East one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mile on the South line of Section 34 which is the dividing line between Clinton and Marion Townships.

WHEREAS, the landowners along road Number 560 and 372 will donate right of way for the widening and the improving of the three miles of road between the Sibleyville-Glathe and Vinland-Clearfield Roads which are now in the County System or the extension of the Deamer Road to the Vinland-Clearfield Road.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, State of Kansas, in regular session assembled this 29th day of December, 1947, do grant the addition of the following description of township road to the County System of highways, and same to be removed from township system of designated townships.

Beginning at the northeast corner of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 20 East along the East line of Section 35, 1 mile which is in Eudora Township; thence South along the East line of Section 2 and 11, Township 14 South, Range 20 East, in Palmyra Township have two miles, to the Southeast corner of Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 20 East, or the intersection of the Vinland-Clearfield Road.
