RESOLUTION

February 21, 1948.

To the Honorable Mayor, James H. Parsons, and the City Councilmen of the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

Gentlemen:

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on the 21st day of February, 1948, passed a motion creating a sanitary sewer district, the same to be sanitary sewer district Number Seven, embracing the following described real estate, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the West line of the North East Quarter of Section Six (6) in Township Thirteen (13) South of Range Twenty (20), East of the 6th P. M. 843.08 feet North of the South West corner of said Quarter Section, thence East Parallel to the South line of said Quarter Section, 19 rods, thence North 300 feet; thence Westerly to a point 296 feet North of beginning, thence South 296 feet to place of beginning, in Douglas County, Kansas.

The motion by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, further provides that the motion creating said district is conditioned upon the City of Lawrence approving the connection of said sewer district with the city sewer at approximately 17th and Barker Streets.

The Board of County Commissioners respectfully request permission to connect said sewer district with the city sewer system at approximately 17th and Barker Streets in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and agree to enter into a contract in regard to said sewer district and the maintenance thereof, as has been previously done in Sewer Districts Four, Five and Six.
