rides. Said boat shall be used only the the Lake Superintendent, or by the Lake Governing Board, for official business and lake inspection purposes.

Party of the second part shall rent all buildings available for occupancy in the park designated for rental and at such prices as designated by the parties of the first part.

Party of the second part shall keep all buildings in a clean and sanitary condition. In those buildings containing mattresses, said mattress covers shall be kept laundered and in a clean, sanitary condition.

Party of the second part shall keep an accurate record of all monies received from all sources and all disbursements made to conform with County auditing customs.

Each week the party of the second part shall turn over all monies collected from rentals and license fees to the County Clerk, or County Engineer, as designated by the parties of the first part, and party of the second part shall be allowed a mileage at the rate of five cents (5¢) per mile for turning over all monies collected for rental and license fees when it is necessary to bring said money to the Court House in Lawrence, Kansas, and provided further that no more than five trips per month shall be made in turning over said money.

Party of the second part must give satisfactory bond as shall be necessary for a party handling/County monies.

Party of the second part shall keep a Guest Register for public scrutiny containing date of occupancy of said rental buildings or cabins, signature of guest, number of persons in party, rental price paid, and motor vehicle license number.

Party of the second part shall have the right to sell concession rights at any time, but must first obtain written consent of parties of the first part.

Party of the second part shall not assign this lease, or sub-rent or sub-let said premises, or any part thereof, without first obtaining the written consent of the parties of the first part.
