The Bound of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Bcard being present.

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were approved and allowed by the Board as per the Allowrace Record.

Hearing for the petition from the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence to annex the property between Wineteenth and Twenty-First Streets West of Louisiana Street, consisting of 372 acres, was held at 9:00 o'clock A. M. After proper motion, second, and on vote called, the Board allowed the petition, and the following resolution was adopted:

MIEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, did on the 10th day of April, 1946, file with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, its petition to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, for authority and approval to enlarge the limits of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, by adding the following adjacent territory thereto:
