

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD N

Douglas County Republican, Lawrence

The East 50 acres of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, Township 12, South; Range 19 East of the 6th P.M. less the following Blocks 1-2 and 4 West Hills an addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, also beginning at the Southeast corner of Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, Township 12 South, Range 19 East of the 6th P.M.; thence West 16 rods, North 12 rods, East 16 rods, South 12 rods to point of beginning, also described as follows: beginning at the center of Section 36, Township 12 South, Range 19 East of the 6th P.M., thence South 305 feet to North line of West Hills Terrace; thence West 33 feet; thence on a curve of 330 foot radius to the left 200.65 feet; thence on a curve of 300 foot radius to the left 90 feet; thence on a curve of 50 foot radius to the right 85.7 feet to the north line of West Hills Parkway; thence on a curve of 211 foot radius to the left 165.9 feet; thence on a curve of 235 foot radius to the left 112.9 feet; thence on a curve of 157 foot radius to the left 223.85 feet to the west line of Emory Road; thence on a curve of 50 foot radius to the right 16.74 feet; thence South 44.51 feet; thence on a curve of 100 foot radius to the right 71.56 feet; thence South 41°-01' West 70.44 feet; thence on a curve of 150 foot radius to the left 79.3 feet; thence South 10°-43' West 128.45 feet; thence on a curve of 1150 foot radius to the left 324.5 feet to the north line of University Drive and west line of Emory Road; thence West 240.25 feet; thence South 33 feet to center of University Drive; thence West 798.1 feet more or less to the Southwest corner of West Hills; thence North 1320.7 feet more or less to the Northwest corner of West Hills and the center line of Section 36; thence East 1464.97 feet to a point 188.5 feet West of center of Section 36; thence North 120 feet; thence East 188.5 feet; thence South 120 feet to place of beginning, in Douglas County, Kansas,

and to make a finding as to the advisability of adding said territory to said City, all as provided by 12-501 of R. S., 1935, and

WHEREAS, the said matter was duly set for hearing on the 5th day of May, 1948, at 10:00 o'clock a.m., in the Commissioner's room of the Court House of Douglas County, Kansas, in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing was duly published for three consecutive weeks as provided by law in the Lawrence Daily Journal World, the same being a newspaper of general circulation in said City, and

WHEREAS, on the aforesaid date and time and at the aforementioned place, the said Board of County Commissioners, all of the members of said Board being present, did proceed to hear testimony as to the advisability of making the addition requested in the above mentioned petition, as provided in 12-502 of R.S. 1935, and

WHEREAS, after hearing testimony as above mentioned, the said Board of County Commissioners did take the matter under advisement until the 8th day of May, 1948, and

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of May, 1948, the said Board of County Commissioners in regular adjourned meeting, all of the members of said Board being present, having fully considered the testimony presented at the above mentioned hearing, did find that the adding of the above described property to the said City is to its best interest and will cause no manifest injury to the persons owning real estate sought to be added,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular adjourned meeting this 8th day of May, 1948, all of the members of said Board being present, that the governing body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, shall have and is hereby granted authority and approval to enlarge the limits of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, by adding thereto the adjacent territory as above described.
