The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, Ed Johnson and L. H. Griffith being present.

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were approved and allowed by the Board as per the Allowance Record.

The Board signed a resolution forming a cemetery district according to the petition filed with the Board by Arthur Wulfkuhle, representative of the Stull Cemetery Association, resolution as follows:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a petition setting forth a proposed cemetery district, hereinafter described, and signed by not less than fifty-one per cent of the qualified electors of said proposed district, which has been determined by an enumeration taken and verified for this purpose by Arthur Wulfkuhle, a qualified elector of said proposed district, has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in which lies all of the territory comprising said district, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners at its next regular meeting this 14th day of August, 1948, did examine said petition and did find that said petition is regular and in due form as provided in Section 17-1330 of the 1947 Supplement to the General Statutes of Kansas, 1935,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular meeting assembled this 14th day of August, 1948, a quorum of said Board being present, that they shall and do hereby enter an order in their proceedings establishing the following described cemetery district:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 11, Twp. 13, Rg. 17, thence East on the South lines of Sections 11 and 12, in Twp. 13, Rg. 17, and thence continue East on South lines of Sections 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Southeast corner of said Section 11, Twp. 13, Rg. 18, thence North on East lines of Sections 11 and 2, Twp. 13, Rg. 18, and continue North on East line of Sections 35, 26 and 23 to Northeast corner of said Section 23, thence West on North line of Sections 23 and 22 to Northwest corner of said Section 22, thence North on East line of Section 16 to Northeast corner of said Section 16, thence West on North line of Sections 16, 17, 18 all in Twp. 12, Rg. 18, and continue West on North line of Section 13 to Northwest corner of Northeast Quarter said Section 13, Twp. 12, Rg. 17, thence South on West line of said NE 1/4 Section 13 on half section line to Highway 40, thence in Southeasterly direction along said Highway 40 to East line of Section 13, Twp. 12, Rg. 17, thence South to the Southeast corner of said Section 13, thence West on South lines of Sections 13 and 14 to the Southwest corner of said Section 14, thence South on West lines of Sections 23, 26 and 35, all in Twp. 12, Rg. 17, thence continue South on West lines of Sections 2 and 11 to Southwest corner of said Section 11, in Twp. 12, Rg. 17, to the point of beginning, all in Douglas County, Kansas.
