The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

A Road Petition, signed by E. Otis Perkins and Others, was presented to the Board, requesting the Board close a road in Section 4, Township 13, Range 19. The Board could see no necessity of having a Viewing, and passed the following resolution closing the road, the original copy of the resolution being on file in the County Engineers Office:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a petition for the vacation of a road in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in accordance with Section 68-102 of the 1947 Supplement to the General Statutes of Kansas for 1935, signed by E. Otis Perkins and twelve other householders of the county residing in the vicinity where said road is now located; and said petition requests that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, vacate a road as described in said petition.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, finds that said petition has been filed according to law and that said petition can be heard without further notice.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, finds that Douglas County, Kansas, has a population of less than 45,000 and more than 1200 inhabitants, and said commissioners further find that the road as described in said petition is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, and inconvenient and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, further finds that the road as described in said petition to be vacated is less than two miles long.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, in regular session assembled this 30th day of October, 1948, that the road described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 4, Township 13, Range 19 in Douglas County, Kansas, thence West on Section Line 3.28 chs. to a point, thence North 73° West 19.20 chs. to a point, thence South 59½° West 11.10 chs. to a point on the North line of the Sec. 4-13-19, thence West on Section Line 8.85 chs. to the Northwest corner of the Northeast ¼ of Sec. 4-13-19. Said road is 40 feet in width in Douglas County, Kansas.
