The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular session, all members of the Board being present, to sign the payroll.

Bills for equipment and supplies were approved and allowed by the Board as per the Allowance Record.

Commissioners Cancellation Orders Nos. 537 and 538 were approved by the Board.

Register of Deeds Harold A. Beck was authorized to purchase one stenographers chair at a price of \$19.50.

County Attorney Robert B. Oyler presented to the Board two petitions to enlarge the boundaries of the City of Lawrence, presented by the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, signed by J. H. Parsons, Mayor, on file in office of County Clerk. One, Marked Exhibit "A", petitions the County Commissioners for authority and approval to enlarge the limits of the City of Lawrence, by adding the following adjacent territory thereto, South of 19th-West of Louisiana. Two, marked Exhibit "B", petitions the County Commissioners for authority and approval to enlarge the limits of the City of Lawrence, by adding the following adjacent territory thereto, South of 15th-East of Barker.

The Board instructed the County Attorney to draw up a Notice of Publication, and to set the date for the hearing to be December 22, 1948. The time for hearing for Exhibit "A" will be 9:00 o'clock A. M., and the time for hearing for Exhibit "B" will be 10:00 o'clock A. M.

County Clerk T. R. Gerhart appeared before the Board with an itemized list of the expenses of the County for the General Election held on November 2, 1948, said list being approved by the Board.

The Board met by appointment at 9:30 o'clock A. M. with a Mr. VanDeusen, representing the International Business Machines Corporation, to discuss the purchase of an electric typewriter to be used in typing tax statements.

After discussion, the Board authorized County Clerk T. R. Gerhart to purchase one electric typewriter from the International Business Machines Corporation with a Standard 16 inch carriage, standard pica type, at a price of \$360.00, to be taken from the County Clerks fund, with a 90 day guarantee. A service contract with International Business Machines will be signed by the Board at \$30.00 a year.
