The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were approved and allowed by the Board as per the Allowance Record.

Noxious Weed Supervisor Ebon Anderson appeared before the Board with his application for supervisor for the year 1949, which was accepted by the Board at his present salary.

The Board passed the following resolution authorizing the sale of certain County property located between New York Street and Connecticut Street facing South on 7th Street, resolution as follows:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at regular session on this 5th day of January, 1949, the following Commissioners being present: Chairman, Ed Johnson, Commissioner, L. H. Griffith, and Commissioner, Elmer W. Ousdahl.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously finds that it is to the best interest of Douglas County, Kansas to sell, as provided by Section 19-211 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1935, the following described real property, owned and in the possession of said County, excepting all buildings now on said property, to-wit:

Lots 15, 17 and 19 on New York Street in the City of Lawrence,
Douglas County, Kansas;
and
Lots 14, 16, 18 and 20 on Connecticut Street in the City of
Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, further unanimously finds that the value of the above described real property is over the sum of \$500.00 and is less than \$5,000.00, and the actual value of said property is approximately \$3,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in regular session assembled this 5th day of January, 1949, that the above described real property except all buildings thereon be sold for cash, as provided by Section 19-211 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1935, and that publication notice be given for at least 20 days of said purposed sale in some newspaper, printed in the English language, generally circulated in Douglas County, Kansas.
