RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of January, 1949, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, of Douglas County, the application of the Country Club, A. L. Roberson, Manager, for a beer license came on for consideration of said Board, and,

WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said Country Club is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Wakarusa Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objection has been filed by the Wakarusa Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant, the Lawrence Country Club, A. L. Roberson, Manager, be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County, be, and he is hereby directed to issue said license.

Elmer W. Ousdahl was designated as a member of the Douglas County Health Board for 1949.

The Register of County Employees as of January 1, 1949, was presented to the Board by Budget Director Mildred LeSuer, said register being approved by the Board and entered in this book on separate sheet as of this date. The Board tabled the budgeted raises in wages.

County Surveyor C. E. Redmond appeared before the Board with seven resolutions to be signed by the Board, authorizing the vacating of seven roads in Douglas County, said resolutions being approved and signed by the Board, and entered into the Minutes as follows:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously find that it would be to the best interests of Douglas County, Kansas, to close Road No. 614 as provided in Section 68-102 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1945.

Beginning at a point 225 feet North of the Northeast corner of Section 12, Township 13 South, Range 20 East, thence West 80 rods to a point 243 feet North of the South line of Section 1, thence South 243 feet to the South line of said Section 1, this road being closed is part of road No. 614.

ADOPTED this 12th day of January, 1949, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County at a regular session held in Lawrence, Kansas.
