The Board passed the following resolution conveying to the City of Lawrence the interest of the County in the rails, ties, and trolley poles on the Kaw River Bridge at Lawrence, Kansas, copy of which is sent to City Clerk; copy of which is filed in the office of County Clerk:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at regular session on this 5th day of March, 1949, the following Commissioners being present: Chairman Elmer W. Cusdahl, Commissioner Charles E. Banning, and Commissioner Ray C. Ogden; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 1916, Douglas County, Kansas, entered into a contract with the Kansas City Kaw Valley and Western Railway Company, a Corporation, wherein Douglas County, Kansas, furnished all rails, ties and trolley poles on a bridge known as the Kansas River Bridge located in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, said contract being recorded in Book I at Page 82 of the Douglas County Commissioners Record Book in the County Clerk's Office of Douglas County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1942, Douglas County, Kansas, by a Resolution released and assigned all its interest in and to any right and interest said County had to the collecting of rentals for the use of said bridge, to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, said Resolution being recorded in Book N at Page 193 of the Douglas County Commissioners Record Book in the County Clerk's office of Douglas
