WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now finds that it is to the best interest of Douglas County, Kansas, that any interest said County has in and to the rails, ties and trolley poles on said bridge be released and assigned to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, for any disposition said city may wish to make of them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that said county release and assign to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, any interest and right said County may have to rails, ties and trolley poles located on the Kansas River Bridge in Lawrence, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due an legal notice has been given to the Wakarusa Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objection has been filed by the Wakarusa Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant, Ruth Moll be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County be and he is hereby directed to issue said license.
