RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular adjourned session this 27th day of June, 1949, the following commissioners being present: Chairman, Elmer W. Ousdahl; Commissioner, Charles E. Banning; and Commissioner, Ray C. Ogden.

WHEREAS, the said Board passed a resolution on the 18th day of June, 1949, providing for the sale of certain lots described as follows:

Lots 86, 88 and 90 less the East 25 feet thereof,
and all of Lots 47 and 49 in Block 21 in that
part of the City of Lawrence known as West
Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas

and said Board of County Commissioners now finds that it does not own all of Lot 86 above described, and said board hereby rescinds said order and resolution and hereby orders that all proceedings under said resolution are void.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, in regular adjourned session assembled this 27th day of June, 1949, that the resolution passed by said board on the 18th day of June, 1949, be and the same is hereby rescinded and held for naught for the reason that said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did not own all of said real property as stated in said resolution.
