

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD O

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The Board passed the following resolution to sell lots owned by the County in West Lawrence, resolution as follows:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met in regular adjourned session on this 27th day of June, 1949, the following Commissioners being present, Chairman, Elmer W. Ousdahl; Commissioner, Charles E. Banning; and Commissioner, Ray C. Ogden.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously finds that it is to the best interest of Douglas County, Kansas, to sell, as provided by Section 19-211 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1935, the following described real property owned and in the possession of said county, excepting all buildings now on said property and reserving an easement on and under said property for the purpose of maintaining and repairing the sewage line running from the Douglas County Convalescent Hospital to Maine Street, to-wit:

The South Half of Lot 86, less the East 25 feet thereof, all of Lot 88, and all of Lot 90 less the East 25 feet of said lots and all of Lots 47 and 49, all in Block 21, in that part of the City of Lawrence known as West Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, further unanimously finds that the value of the above described property is over the sum of \$500.00 and is less than \$5,000.00 and the actual value of said property is approximately \$2250.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, in regular adjourned session assembled this 27th day of June, 1949, that the above described real property, excepting all buildings thereon, and reserving an easement on and under said property for the purpose of maintaining and repairing the sewage line running from the Douglas County Convalescent Hospital to Maine Street, be sold for cash as provided by Section 19-211 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1935, and that publication notice be given for at least twenty days of said proposed sale in some newspaper, printed in the English language, generally circulated in Douglas County, Kansas.
