That a Warranty Deed conveying good title be made, executed and delivered to said doctors by said county trans-ferring the above described real property to said doctors upon the payment of the sum of \$2,000.00 of which \$200.00 has been received, and said conveyance being subject to the option of said county to repurchase said property as provided by the bid bf said property for the purpose of maintaining and repairing the sewage line running from the Douglas County Convalescent Hospital to Maine Street.
