The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, all members of the Board being present.

Welfare Director Mildred Watson appeared before the Board to discuss Welfare problems.

Earl A. Farris, representative of the World Co., printers, and Roy Flory, County Treasurer, appeared before the Board to discuss a slight irregularity in the printing of part of the personal property tax receipts.

After discussion, Mr. Farris agreed to furnish a girl to check through the tax receipts for the irregularities, and to pay her for the time spent doing the work.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of September, 1949, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, of Douglas County, the application of Karl Kappelman, for a beer license came on for consideration of said Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board does find that the said Karl Kappelman is in all ways qualified under the law to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that due and legal notice has been given to the Wakarusa Township Board and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objection has been filed by the Wakarusa Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant, Karl Kappelman be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County, be and he is hereby directed to issue said license.
