The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular session, all members of the Board being present.

Noxious Weed Supervisor, Ebon Anderson, appeared before the Board to discuss problems pertaining to that office.

Bids for new cars for the Sheriffs office were opened by the Board at 9:30 A. M. The motion was made by Mr. Banning, seconded by Mr. Ogden, and on vote called, carried, the Board will defer action on the bids until Wednesday, September 28, 1949.

The Board met by appointment at 10:00 A. M. with the Eudora Township Board to discuss an equalizer on the road between Sections 1 & 7, in Township 13, Range 21. The County Engineer was instructed to notify the Eudora Township Board what and when to do.

The Board signed the deed transferring the lots next those at the Convalescent Home, resolution as of July 23, 1949, to four doctors, namely, Dr. H. Penfield Jones, Dr. Raymond A. Schwegler, Dr. Raymond Pendleton and Dr. Mary Boyden, for the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), said lots being: The South half of Lot 86, less the East 25 feet thereof, all of Lot 88, and all of Lot 90, less the East 25 feet of said lots, and all of Lots 47 and 49, all in Block 21, in that part of the City of Lawrence, known as West Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.
